1. The meeting was opened at 5:30
2. Taney Browder offered the prayer
3. Chief Reese informed the committee that Manager Rush was unable to attend this meeting and would be at the next meeting to provide guidance as to the rules and regulations regarding the committee with respect to: meeting requirements, procedures, communications, public records laws, etc... A copy of the by-laws for the Bike and Pedestrian Committee was provided to the committee members for their review, with a recommendation that they begin drafting their own.
4. A decision was made to table the election of officers to the next board meeting to give the members a chance to get to know one another.
5. Discussion/committee of goals & concerns
  - The committee discussed fund raising possibilities to increase access on the island. Several ideas were discussed, but no decisions were made.
  - Taney Browder brought up consideration of the fees for registration and possibly lowering the fees. Chief Reese informed him that the fees were set by the Board of Commissioners and that they would have to make a recommendation to the Board.
  - There was discussion about expanding the number of golf cart parking spaces available along Ocean Dr. Taney Browder stated that he had identified several locations where spaces could be added. It was decided that he would make a presentation regarding these locations at the following meeting in May. Chief Reese provided an updated map to the board of the current golf cart parking locations and number of spaces. There was discussion about breaking down the island into areas and assigning each member areas of responsibility to identify locations where parking spaces could be added. No assignments were made.
  - There were questions regarding the current rules and regulations discussed at the last meeting. Chief Reese provided answers to those questions.
