

## Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Golf Cart Advisory Committee

Tuesday, June 19, 2018, 5:30 p.m.

- I. Chairman Taney Browder called the meeting to order.
- II. Taney Browder called roll. Present were Browder, Chris Blythe, Ted Harrell, Michael Ayers, Martha Levey, Chief Tony Reese.
- III. Taney Browder gave the opening prayer.
- IV. Taney Browder led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- V. The minutes from the May meeting were approved.
- VI. The agenda for the June meeting was adopted.
- VII. Old Business – Additional parking spaces have been added on Ocean Drive at Azure and Nina and more spaces on Ocean Drive will added in the fall. 3 walkway replacements are planned for fall which can be design coordinated to include golf cart parking. Donations made to the committee that are designated to the golf cart advisory committee are tax deductible.
- VIII. Chief Reese shared information on registered golf cart members in areas off Coast Guard Road that might be interested in fundraising options to develop a golf cart path on Coast Guard Road. Reese pointed out that those who do not have golf carts are not on that list but might be interested in participating in fundraising activities.
- IX. New Business – Rios Landscaping has submitted an estimate totaling \$34,716 for construction of a golf cart path along Coast Guard Road, between Osprey Ridge and Bell Cove Landing. The estimate includes the path as well as prep work needed. Ted Harrell announced there will be a private golf cart club that will help with fundraising. The initial meeting was scheduled for July 12 at Salt Night Club in Emerald Isle. The committee discussed the importance of considering longer parking spaces to accommodate longer golf carts.
- X. Items to be discussed at July meeting - The committee asked that information about the golf cart advisory committee be shared through town email and Emerald Tidings.
- XI. There were no comments from committee members.
- XII. The meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m. The next meeting will be July 17 at 5:30 p.m. in the Town Board Meeting Room.
