

Golf Cart Advisory Meeting (Approved)
August 20, 2019

The Golf Cart Advisory Committee met on Tuesday, Aug. 20, 2019, in the Emerald Isle meeting room at 5:30 p.m.

- I. Chairman Taney Browder called the meeting to order.
- II. Secretary Martha Levey called roll. Present were Browder, Chris Blythe, Levey, Paul Buchanan, Michael Ayers, Chief Tony Reese and Town Manager Matt Zapp. Absent were Ted Harrell and Michael Taylor.
- III. Zapp led the opening prayer.
- IV. Browder led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- V. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.
- VI. The agenda for the August meeting was adopted.
- VII. Old Business
 - a. Zapp shared that the N.C. Department of Transportation was not receptive of allowing a golf cart path on the NC 58 right-away on the north side of NC 58 between the dogleg area (Dollar General) and 25th Street since that area could potentially be considered for lane expansion in the future.
 - b. Zapp shared a memo summary outlining a golf cart parking area adjacent to the beach access area. The space could potentially provide parking for 10 to 12 carts. This would be a Beta test area and if successful, sites at Lee Ave./Ocean Dr., Joel/Ocean Dr. and 13th Street/Ocean Dr. would be considered for improvements to add additional parking. The committee unanimously passed a motion to ask Zapp to take the design to the Board of Commissioners at the September meeting (sketch attached).
- VIII. There was no new business.
- IX. The Committee asked for an update on the board's response at their September meeting.
- X. There were no comments from committee members.
- XI. The meeting was adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
