

## Golf Cart Advisory Committee Meeting

### Minutes (for Approval)

The Golf Cart Advisory Committee Meeting was called to order. The meeting was held in the town hall meeting room.

- I. Chairman Taney Browder called the meeting to order.
- II. Chairman Browder took the roll. Present were committee members Taney Browder, Michael Taylor, Travis Speight, Jay Thomas, Jim Blanton. Town Representatives present were Assist. Police Chief Mike Panzarella, Town Manager Matt Zapp, Parks & Rec, Alesia Sanderson & GIS Teck Greg Flinn, Absent was Chris Blythe, and Paul Buchanan(resigned).
- III. Chief Reese led the prayer.
- IV. Browder led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- V. The minutes from the July 2020 meeting were approved.
- VI. The agenda for the Aug 2020 meeting was adopted w/ correction.
- VII. Old Business
  - a. Mike Panzarella reminded Committee that breakdown of GCP'ing would be in 3 major geographical areas, Coast Guard Rd. to Bus. District, Bus. Dist. To Pinta, & Pinta to east Town's limits. Greg Flinn/GIS presented summaries of all the Town's Public Parking as well as GCPing, GCPing violations locations, w/ #'s broken down by access locations in 3 major areas, & is to email committee these worksheets. Committee is to review this info in prep for next meeting in order to generate GCPing priority list. Alesia Sanderson provided a list (recently updated) of all beach accesses locations w/ rating/deterioration, access ROW width, lengths etc. for coordination of prior priority list.
  - b. Discussion of need for generation of questionnaire to be disseminated via town's website, and other means such as FB, to get public's feedback on level of support for additional beach and sound access GCP'ing. Initial thoughts were to be limited to 3 or 4 questions which committee is to bring to next mtg.
  - c. Sanderson updated committee on current access constructions: James St. largely done, waiting for GC to install the HC GCPing space at end of new wooden walk, Randy's Way is under construction, & Channel Dr. Boardwalk Contract has been issue & will start based on GC's schedule.
  - d. Mike Panzarella informed committee that No GC's allowed stencils have been installed on north side/58 at Bogue Inlet, and southwest side of CG Rd.& Reed Dr.
