Beach Driving Permit Rules and Regulations

1. **ALL** North Carolina Motor Vehicle laws apply to vehicles operating on the beach strand.
2. Beach Driving stickers **are required** to be permanently affixed and displayed in the lower left hand corner (driver's side) of the windshield. Loose or unattached stickers **will be confiscated** by the police department. All previous years stickers **are required** to be removed from the windshield. Lost or stolen stickers will not be replaced. This sticker may **NOT** be transferred to another vehicle.
3. The speed limit on the beach strand is **20MPH**.
4. Pedestrians have the right of way. Vehicles should reduce speed and avoid driving near beachgoers.
5. Avoid sea turtle nests and other wildlife while operating your vehicle on the beach strand.
6. Driving on the dunes is prohibited. Vehicles should stay a minimum of 10 feet away from the primary dunes.
7. Beach driving hours are:
 - September 15th to November 3rd – 5:00am to 9:00pm
 - November 4th to March 7th – 5:00am to 7:00pm
 - March 8th to April 30th – 5:00am to 9:00pm
 All vehicles must be off the beach by the closing time. Vehicles not off the beach may be cited by the police department.
8. Authorized beach access ramps for entry and exit are located at the following locations:
 - Ocean Drive Ramp - dog leg (near mile marker 15 on NC 58)
 - Black Skimmer Ramp – Black Skimmer Drive (across from the police department)
 - Point Ramp – at the terminus of Inlet Drive and Bogue Ct.
9. The Town Manager has the right under EITO Section 5-63 to close all or certain portions of the beach strand to beach driving. Vehicles shall not enter any area posted as **CLOSED**.
10. Permit holders are required to notify the Emerald Isle Police Department of any changes to the information provided for this permit.

I certify, under risk of forfeiture of privilege, that I have received a copy of the rules and regulations outlined above and that I have read, understand and agree to strictly adhere to all rules and regulations set forth and pertaining to beach driving within the Town of Emerald Isle. I further acknowledge that beach driving is a privilege that may be revoked by the Town of Emerald Isle at any time for violations of the rules and regulations and that NO refunds be will be given if my permit is revoked.
