The Emerald Isle Parks & Recreation Department offers numerous active and passive recreational opportunities for folks of all ages.

BEACH / SOUND ACCESS & PARKS

PARK HOURS ARE SUNRISE TO SUNSET

OVERNIGHT PARKING PROHIBITED

Western Ocean Regional Access

(WORA): Located 0.4 miles from the B. Cameron Langston Bridge, between the Islander Motor Inn and Queen's Court Condominiums. Parking is available for 168 cars with handicapped public beach access, two sand volleyball courts, picnic pavilion with grills on site, restrooms, foot bath and showers. There is a \$4.00 fee charge per hour or a maximum of 16.00 per vehicle, including holiday weekends. Paid

parking starts April thru Sept between the hours of 8am - 6pm, 7-days a week during this period. Reservations are not accepted. First come, first serve.

Eastern Ocean Regional Access

(EORA): Located 6.4 miles from the B. Cameron Langston Bridge, between Pier Point and Ocean Reef condominiums at 2701 Emerald Dr. Parking is available for 167 cars with public beach access, picnic area on site, restrooms, foot bath and showers. There is a \$4.00 fee charge per hour or a maximum of 16.00 per vehicle, including holiday weekends. Paid parking starts April thru Sept between the hours of 8am - 6pm, 7-days a week during this period. Reservations are not accepted. First come, first serve.

NC Wildlife Resources Commission Boat

Launching Facility in Emerald Isle: Located on Bogue Sound at 6800 Emerald Drive near mile marker 18 on NC 58 (adjacent to Chapel By The Sea). The facility includes 4 launching ramps and parking for 112 vehicle / trailer combinations and a separate parking lot with 18 single vehicle spaces. The new facility is managed by the NC Wildlife Resources Commission, and is open 24/7/365. There is no fee to launch a boat.

Senator Jean Preston Memorial Park: Sound front playground located directly adjacent to the Emerald Isle Public Boating Access Area.

Emerald Isle Woods: Located at 9404 Coast Guard Rd, this sound-side, 41-acre park features walking trails and sound access, boardwalk with floating dock to Bogue Sound, disc golf course, picnic pavilion, and restrooms. Grills on site; first come first serve.

Blue Heron Park & Tennis/Pickleball Courts-open until 11pm:

Located behind the Police Department, this park offers a variety of recreational facilities, including two lighted tennis courts, four pickleball courts, a basketball court, picnic tables, and a playground. Reservations are required to use the tennis and pickleball courts. For more information, visit www.emeraldisle-nc.org.

Cedar Street Park: Located at the end of Cedar Street on the Sound Side. Parking available for 4

cars, picnic table and pier with kayak and wind-surfing access.

Third Street Park: Located on Ocean Drive & accessible from First & Fifth Streets. Parking available for 8 cars with Public Beach Access.

Park Street Park: Located at the end of Park St. on sound side. Parking available at EORA across Emerald Dr. Kayak launching area.

Station Street Park: Located at 11001 Coast Guard Rd., near "the point." Parking is available for 16 cars. Short walk to the beach.

Ocean Oaks Park: Located in the Ocean Oaks subdivision off Coast Guard Rd.

A neighborhood park with playground equipment & a grill.

Oceanside Vehicular Public

Accesses:

Beach driving is allowed during the period from September 15 through April 30. Beach driving is not allowed, however, between the Thursday before Easter weekend and the Monday that occurs 8 days after Easter Sunday. Permits must be obtained at the Police Department.

Dog Leg ramp-located at the end of Connie St., near mile marker 15-no parking is available.

Black Skimmer Rd-located at the end of Black Skimmer Dr., near mile marker 19 and Town Hall.

The Point Ramp-located at the end of Inlet Dr.

Beach Wheel Chairs: Beach wheelchairs for physically challenged individuals are available for check out from Emerald Isle Fire Station #1, 7508

Emerald Dr. from 8am-5pm, 7 days a week. Reservations are not accepted.

Community Center

Located 203 Leisure Lane adjacent to Town Hall (at 7500 Emerald Isle Realty), the Community Center is a place where you and your family can re-create yourselves. The Center is open Mon-Fri, 7:30am-7:30pm ;Sat 8:30am-3pm; closed on Sun. Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

- ◇ **Fitness Programs:** Offering a variety of classes for every "body!" Including:
 - Yoga, Chair Yoga, Gentle Yoga (mats, straps, blocks and blankets are provided)
 - Aerobics including: 20/20/20, Fab- Fit- Fun, Pound®, Step Aerobics, Tabata, H.I.I.T. and Dance fitness.
- ◇ **Exercise Room:** A comfortable room that participants **ages 16 and up** can enjoy:
 - 5 lower body resistance machines
 - 4 upper body resistance machines
 - 1000+ lbs. of free weights
 - Smith Machine
 - 5 treadmills, 5 elliptical cross-trainers and 3 stationary bikes
 - Medicine balls as well as yoga/exercise balls
- ◇ **Indoor Gymnasium:** A spacious indoor gym with a collegiate-size basketball court used for open-play soccer, basketball, pickleball & more. The gymnasium is also where monthly events take place.
